Celebrate America Recycles Day

America Recycles Day takes place on November 15, 2022. The Blanco County Recycling Center located at 425 Jones Street is self-serve and open seven days a week 24 hours a day. The center has multiple bins for the different recyclables and each bin has a sign to help identify which item goes where. Because of the different containers, it is really easy for Blanco County residents to drop off their recyclables. Paper, aluminum beverage cans, cardboard, glass, cooking, motor oils, steel cans, scrap metals, and oil filters, are all accepted at this center. Plastic is not accepted at this time due to the lack of market. Other items not accepted include automotive parts, garden hoses, PVC pipe, blue tarps, paint, and tires. There is a large red sign at the center that lists the items that can and cannot be recycled to help residents out.

Scenic City Certification

The <u>City of Blanco</u> has achieved Gold Status (80-89% of possible points) for <u>Scenic City</u> Certification. The City is one of six newly qualified cities and there are currently 91 certified Scenic Cities. The certification is valid for five years and then the City will need to recertify.



The Scenic City Certification Program is "to support and recognize the Texas municipalities that implement high-quality scenic standards for public spaces" which include having higher municipal standards, environmental conservation, economic growth and growth management, and high quality of life for citizens. Any Texas city may apply for certification, but there are required criteria needed to be named a Scenic City. These required criteria include trees and landscaping along major roadways, city streets, street medians, and in parking lots; prohibition on new off-premises signage (billboards); and permitting process and size,

placement, and quantity requirements for on-premises signage. Other areas that are reviewed include streetscape enhancement; parks, trails, and open space; lighting standards; design integrity; landscaping; sign control; litter and graffiti prohibition; utility and cable line programs; dumpster screening; and unique municipal features and special programs. After the application was submitted, the application was evaluated by the Scenic City Certification Program Advisory Committee. The benefits of this certification include assessment, analysis, diagnostic, communication, economic development, recognition, and value.
